## CHILDREN & YOUTH MINISTRIES

At New Hope Baptist Church, we've developed a multifaceted children's ministry that takes place in various settings. Our goal is very simple... to reach as many children and ultimately their families with experiences of GOD's love and clear proclamation of the gospel.

### **Angel Choir**

The Angel Choir is open to all children **aged 4 to 7**. We meet every **Saturday 10:30** a.m. in the M C Williams Chapel.

### **Mission Statement**

To develop a love and appreciation for the Word of God through music while creating an early music experience that is meaningful and age appropriate. We provide a nurturing environment that encourages spiritual growth so that each child develops a relationship with God and reaches their full music potential

### **Children's Church**

Children's Church is open to all children aged 5 to 12. We meet every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in the MC Williams Chapel during the 10:45 Morning Worship Service.

Our goal is to develop future church leaders through active participation in skills that teach fellowship, stewardship, discipleship and evangelism. We fully engage the children in bible based learning that is fun and spiritually sound. It provides a spirit-filled environment where persons of all ages can read, examine, and discuss the Word of God. **Devotions start at 9.m. and classes at 9:30 a.m.**

## **Community Affairs Ministry**

The vision of the Community Affairs Ministry is to strengthen and extend the spiritual and religious impact of New Hope Baptist Church in the Denver Metropolitan area and the Region. **Food Ministry**

**“Reaching Out To Lend A Helping Hand”**

The Food Ministry lends a helping hand to our congregation and provides outreach services in our community by feeding their physical bodies and spiritual souls. Three events are done annually; Easter, Thanksgiving and the Christmas luncheons. The ministry provides baskets at Easter and toys at Christmas to children, as well as gifts of toiletries to the adults. We distribute monthly food boxes.

The Gathering Place, The Cornerstone Senior Center, The Denver North Care Center and The Crossing, are some of the shelters we serve.

**The Gathering Place**

The Gathering Place is Denver's only daytime drop-in center for women, children, and transgender individuals who are experiencing homelessness and poverty. New Hope partners with the Gathering Place throughout the year in support of its mission to serve women and children.

**Health Ministry**

The Health Ministry vision is to greatly improve the health and well-being of the New Hope Baptist Church congregation and to improve health education in the greater surrounding communities. The Health Ministry is making this vision a reality by providing just in time education across a wide spectrum of programs that focuses on critical issues such as mental health, the components of the Affordable Care Act, High Blood pressure and heart conditions, cancers, and various health insurance programs.

Providing Health screening Clinics, Educational Seminars and Community Health Fairs are the signature events held at New Hope Baptist Church to promote better physical and spiritual health for the congregation. Through partnerships and collaborations with health providers in the local area, a multitude of educational topics will be presented that cover men and women chronic health issues. Through similar partnerships, Health Fairs will be promoted to offer a variety of health screening clinics to check blood pressure, cholesterol, provide immunizations, etc. for the congregation.

The purpose of the class is to help the children understand more fully the meaning of baptism and why the Church believes in the baptism of believers only (those who believe that Jesus is God's Son and salvation is totally of grace through Jesus).

The class sessions are structured for thirty minutes once a week for three to four weeks. Classes are taught on the children's level, utilizing visual aids in helping to understand the baptismal process. Children are encouraged to take the classes prior to baptism.
